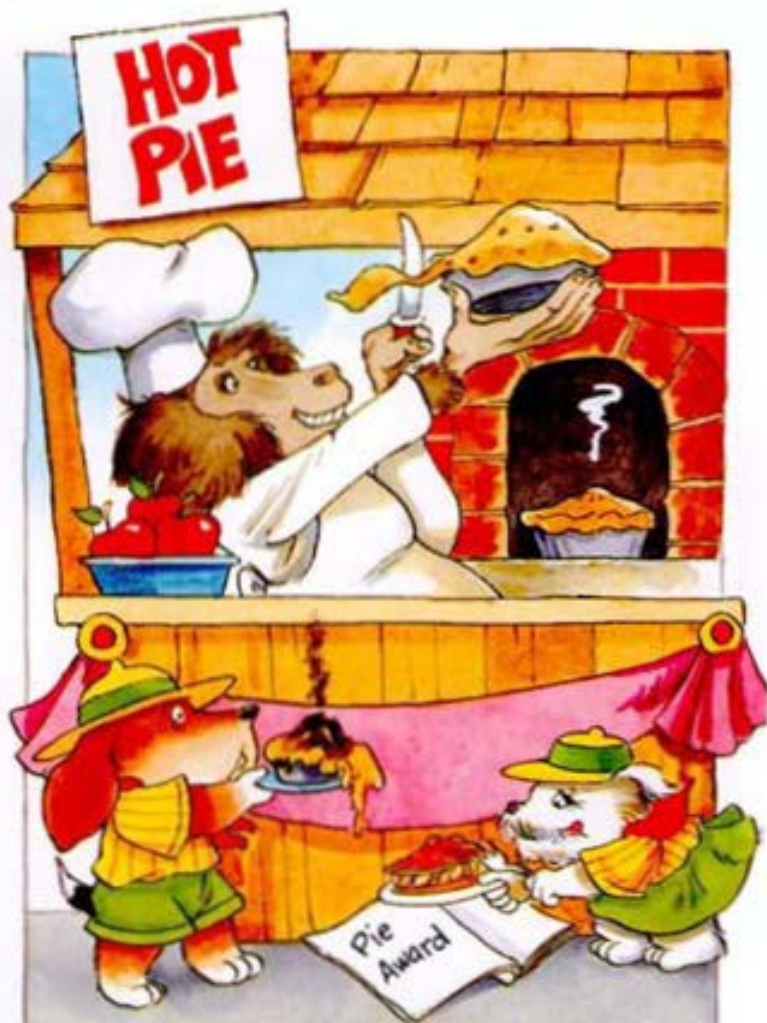

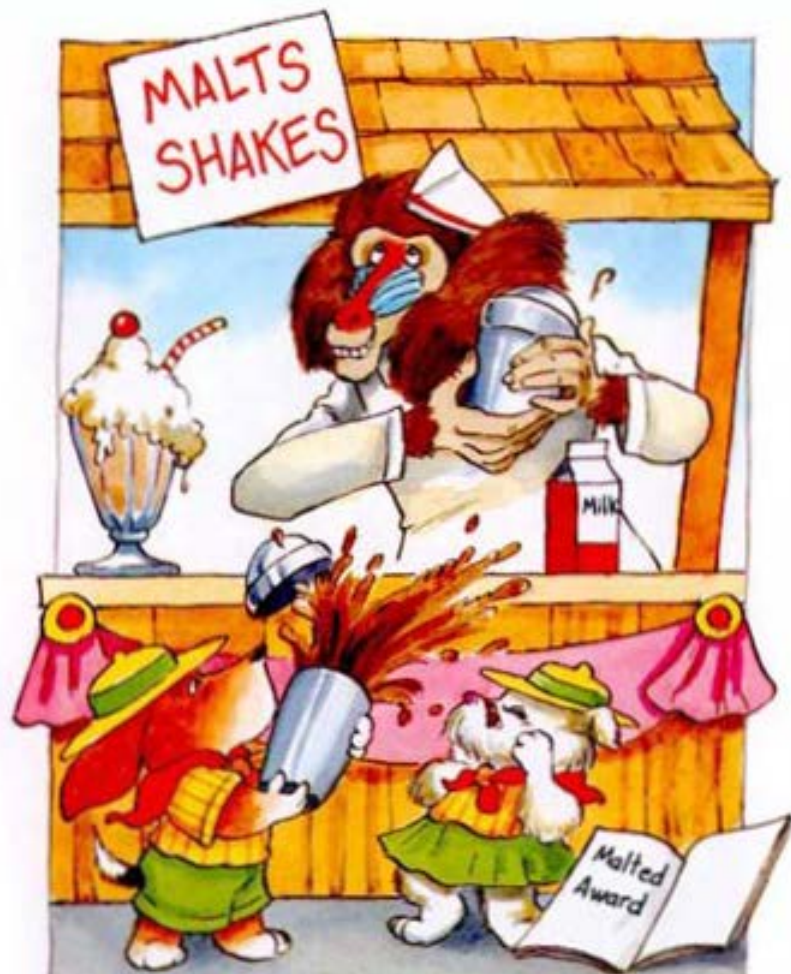

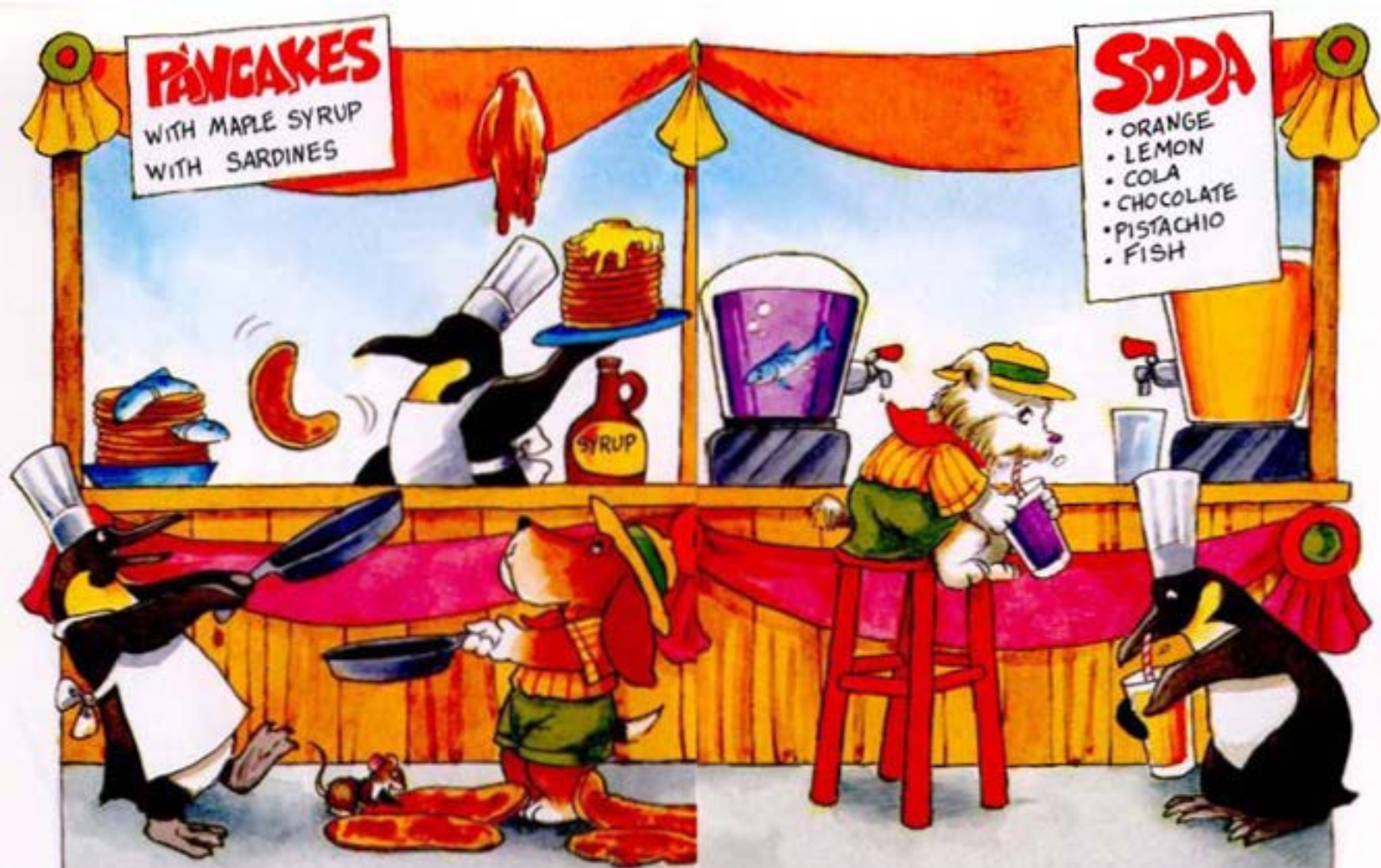

You shake it.

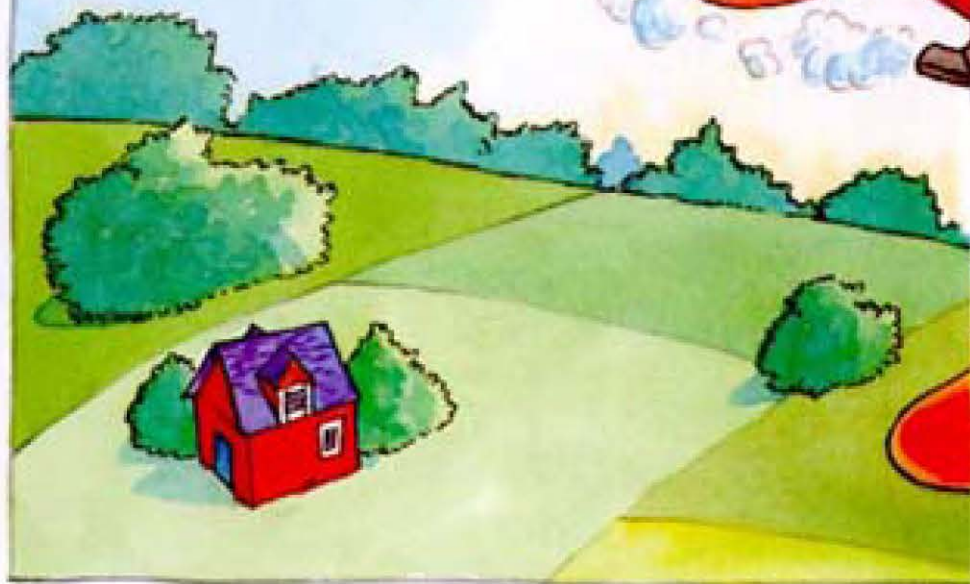


How do you make a pancake?
